

MAINTENANCE REQUIREMENTS

FIRST CLEANING: For cleaning, protection and care, we recommend using products with a neutral pH (7 to 10), as terrazzo is an acid-sensitive product. Cleaning after laying is very important to ensure lasting beauty and preserve the high value of the material for many years. After laying, we recommend removing cement residue and dirt as soon as possible, insufficient or late initial cleaning can change the appearance of the surface. After the mortar is completely dry, it is recommended to clean the surfaces with a specific natural stone product. Always follow the manufacturer's instructions before using natural stone products.

After the initial cleaning, it is recommended to give a protective treatment with an impregnating agent to increase stain resistance and facilitate cleaning. Before grouting and to give the impregnating agent sealer, the surfaces and mortar adhesive must be completely dry. For complete drying, we recommend a waiting time of approx. 4 to 6 weeks. These waiting times are approximate and may vary depending on weather and project conditions. Before sealing the surfaces, it is advisable to clean again with a drying time of approx. 24 hours to remove all dirt residues. We recommend laying only untreated material. Laying treated material can cause problems due to moisture not drying evenly. The result may be colour differences on surfaces and deformation with cracks.

GENERAL MAINTAINANCE: For regular cleaning, we recommend using only warm water with a neutral pH detergent, without additives. Avoid acidic and alkaline cleaning agents. Avoid contact with products such as vinegar, wine, lemon juice or sanitary cleaners (pH < 7). There are acids and can damage surfaces.

For cleaning, protecting and maintaining Terrazzo, we recommend products from Fila or Möller Chemie, or equivalent. Ask your local dealer directly about specific products for maintenance, protection for Terrazzo.
